

London Landmark Half Marathon 2021

Event Terms and Conditions

By registering to run for The HOPE Foundation UK ("HOPE") at the London Landmarks Half Marathon ("LLHM") you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions.

General

- If you are registering other people to participate you are accepting the terms and conditions on their behalf and are confirming that you have been given the authorisation to do so.
- Participants must be 17 or older to take part in LLHM 2021.
- HOPE cannot cover costs associated with training for the LLHM; with transportation to and from the event; or any other costs which you incur as a runner.
- HOPE reserves the right to close registration when participant levels reach capacity.
- You confirm that you are healthy and fit enough to participate in the event activity. If you have any fitness concerns, advice should be sought by your GP in advance of the event.
- HOPE reserves the right to update their terms and conditions in relation to the event at any time prior to the event day.

Event fees, cancellations and refunds

- Once your entry fee of £35 has been paid directly to HOPE, you will receive confirmation of your place and an email to register on the LLHM portal. On the LLHM portal you will need to pay a £2.95 mandatory postage fee to cover the delivery cost of your race pack. (Please note that the entry fee of £35 and postage of £2.95 are the *only* upfront fees and only refundable if a runner cancels within 14 days of signing up. (Each runner is also requested to pledge to raise a minimum of £400 sponsorship – see details outlined below).
- The entry fee of £35 includes a runner's race pack (included in this pack is a LLHM wave and bid number, key information for the race day and a sturdy race bag). The entry fee also includes a runner's goody bag given to each runner on the event day (the goody bag includes a finisher's medal, a high quality technical t-shirt, a finisher's sweatband and LLHM partner's and sponsor's items).
- There is an *optional* purchase via the LLHM online portal of a personalised Itab (which slots into the runner's finisher medal with their name and time).
- If requested by the LLHM, HOPE reserve the right to change any details of the event, such as course distance, the event date, changes to the course, or make any other amendment to the event that is deemed necessary to stage the event. Any change to the event will be communicated to participants as soon as possible.
- Refunds can be requested if there is an event date change. No full or partial refund shall be made for any change in start time provided the event takes place on the already specified date.
- HOPE reserves the right to cancel the event due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control, e.g., due to force majeure or COVID-19 restrictions, or for any safety related reason with no further liability whatsoever arising from such cancellation. In the event of HOPE cancelling the participant will be offered a full refund unless the place is able to be transferred to a different day.
- If you arrive 15 minutes after the official start time of the LLHM, you will not be able to participate in the event and any registration fees will be treated as a donation to HOPE – refunds will not be issued.

Sponsorship

- You will pledge to raise a minimum of £400 for HOPE's work with street children and slum communities in Kolkata. HOPE suggests setting up a Just Giving or Total Giving page to raise these funds and HOPE will actively support and promote your fundraising efforts via HOPE UK's social media platforms.
- HOPE will support you to raise your target and offer fundraising ideas and materials. For this event the sponsorship target covers the cost of a participant's place which HOPE has paid for.
- All sponsorship money will be collected and paid directly to HOPE as soon as possible and within 6 weeks of the event (and no later than 5pm on 5th July 2021). To be paid via Just Giving or Total Giving page, or directly via bank transfer to

- If you are unable to take part in the event, all sponsorship money will be treated as a donation, unless your donors request the return of their sponsorship. In these cases individual donors must be contacted by the participant, who must then ask them to contact HOPE directly.

Communications, marketing, and personal data

- For the purposes of the event, personal information will be collected and may include medical data collected for health and safety purposes.
- Personal information will be stored and used by the HOPE, and the LLHM, and their partners, only in connection with the organisation, staging and administration of the event.
- By registering you agree to receive emails, mail and texts regarding information about this event, which may include location, parking details, health and safety information, recommended clothing and footwear, training advice and fundraising guidance.
- Photographs and video footage taken during the event may be used to publicise this event and the work of HOPE. If you do not wish to appear in any photographs or films please notify the Fundraising & Events Manager at HOPE UK prior to the event.

Liability

- You agree to take part at your own risk. HOPE shall not accept liability for any injury to any person as a result of participation in this event.
- HOPE shall not accept responsibility for loss of or damage to participants' property or property belonging to third parties.
- Any participant that acts negligently, maliciously, with wilful misconduct or otherwise without due care and attention for the event or other participants, to cause the participants removal from the event, will not be entitled to a refund.
- HOPE reserves the right at any time to remove participants from the event.
